

Law No. (43) of 1972 AD

Approving Accession to the Convention on Offences and Certain Other Acts Committed on Board Aircraft Signed in Tokyo in 1963 AD

- Upon review of Constitutional Declaration No. (1) issued on 2 Shawwal 1389 AH, corresponding to 11 December 1969 AD, and
- Based on the submission of the Acting Minister of Unity and Foreign Affairs, and the approval of the Council of Ministers,

Issued the following Law:

Article (1)

The accession of the Libyan Arab Republic to the Convention on Offences and Certain Other Acts Committed on Board Aircraft, signed in Tokyo on 14 September 1963 AD, has been approved.
