

**Law No. (21) of 2012  
amending Law No. (2) of 2001  
on the organisation of political and consular work**

**The National Transitional Council**

**Upon review of:**

- The Victory Declaration of the 17 February Revolution issued on 22 February 2011;
- The decision forming the Interim National Transitional Council and determining its powers;
- The rules of procedure of the National Transitional Council and its internal regulation;
- The Constitutional Declaration issued on 3 August 2011;
- Law No. (2) of 2001 on the organisation of political and consular work, and its executive regulation;
- The proposal of the Prime Minister;
- The outcome of the session of the National Transitional Council held on Sunday, 18/03/2012;

**issued the following law:**

**Article (1)**

Article (14), Paragraph (1) of Law No. (2) of 2001 on organising political and consular work shall be amended to the following text:

“All bodies shall be delegated for work abroad based on a decree by the Cabinet based on a proposal by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation. Financial comptrollers and their assistants shall be exempt therefrom, as they shall be delegated by a proposal by the Ministry of Finance.”

**Article (2)**

This law shall enter into force from its date of issuance, any contrary provision shall be repealed, and it shall be published in the Official Gazette.
